## INTRODUCTION

## **OUESTIONS:**

- · How many of you have a higher comfort number now than you did at the beginning of session 1?
- · What positive changes have you made over the last 6 weeks?
- · What is the favorite thing you discovered about yourself during the Two@aTime Project?
- What was your favorite session? (You may need to remind Team Members of session topics).

One more quick follow-up: In session one, we talked about how much time we spend on social media and how that can sometimes get in the way of having face-to-face conversations.

## **QUESTIONS:**

- How many think you now spend less time on social media? Why or why not?
- · If you spend less time on social media, what positive changes in your life have you noticed?



## **INSIDE THE EPISODE**



Today we will be watching the final episode of Two@aTime. We will get to see what the cast has discovered about themselves and how they plan to make changes in their own lives. We will be watching this episode straight through to the end. At the end, we will discuss what the cast talks about in the video.

## I want you to focus on a few things:

- What cast member do you admire the most? What do you appreciate about them and why?
- What is the cost of not having Two@aTime conversations and reaching out to people who are very different from you?
- What is your commitment moving forward? What will you choose to do with the new knowledge you have?

## **ACTIVITY**

## SPOKEN WORD



We are going to have some fun today and create a spoken word just like Reece and the cast did in today's episode. Reece created a video that will teach us all how to do it! We will be divided into two groups, and each group will create their own unique spoken word. Then, each group will present their spoken word to the other group.

The theme of the spoken word piece is "How Can You Change Your World".

- Break up into two groups and sit together.
- · Have a stack of white sheet paper in middle of tables.
- Have a pen or pencil for each Team Member.
- · Listen to Reece's video and then get started creating. You will have 15 minutes to create.

## **IMPORTANT:**

Have everyone choose 4-5 words that inspire them! Then have Team Members choose one of their words to build into their personal phrase. Each team will put their phrases together and make a spoken word.



- At the end of 15 minutes, each group will present to the other group.
- Each group will have approximately 3-4 minutes to present.

Play video from Reece on Spoken Word

Have fun with this spoken word and remember, it is YOUR CREATION! It is what all of you want to say! I can't wait to hear them. Let's get started!

· When each group has finished, congratulate them for their creativity and powerful commitments.

## **ACTIVITY**

## TWO@ATIME WORK

**ⓑ** 5 Minutes

Now that we have powerful commitments, I want to end the Two@aTime Project with a challenge!

Remember, the goal of Two@aTime is to empower young people like yourselves to better communicate with people who are different from you, people with different skin colors, backgrounds, beliefs, and experiences.

So here is the challenge, if each of you had a Two@aTime conversation with just 2 people, this class alone could meet and talk with about 40 people!
